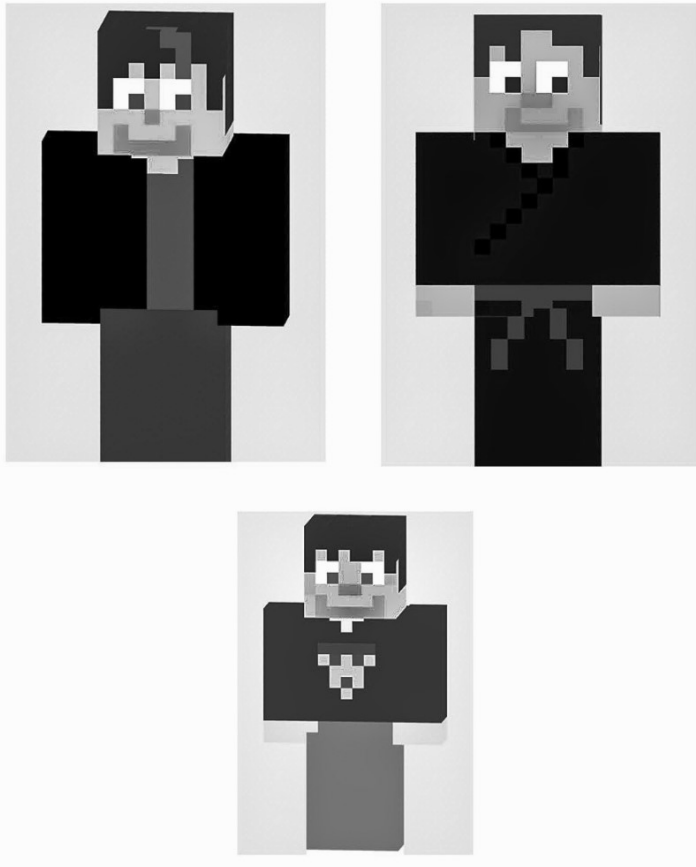

**RECIPE**

SPICE CAKE courtesy of Elsa and Aine's great grandmother

3 eggs (apple sauce)  
3 cups sugar  
¾ cup milk (non-dairy milk)  
¾ cup heavy cream (coconut cream)  
3 cups flour  
¾ Tbsp ginger  
¾ Tbsp cloves  
¾ Tbsp cinnamon  
3 tsp baking powder

Preheat oven to 400-425F. Beat eggs and sugar. Mix dry ingredients and add to egg and sugar mixture alternating with the milk and cream. Pour into two (2) parchment lined 9" x 5" loaf pans. Bake about 35 minutes. Use a toothpick to check if the cakes are ready. The toothpick should come out clean. Cool completely on a cooling rack before peeling off paper and serving. Freezes beautifully. Vegan substitutions in parenthesis.

**SECRET SCOUTS AND THE LOST LEONARDO** by Dennis Kind and Wendel Kind

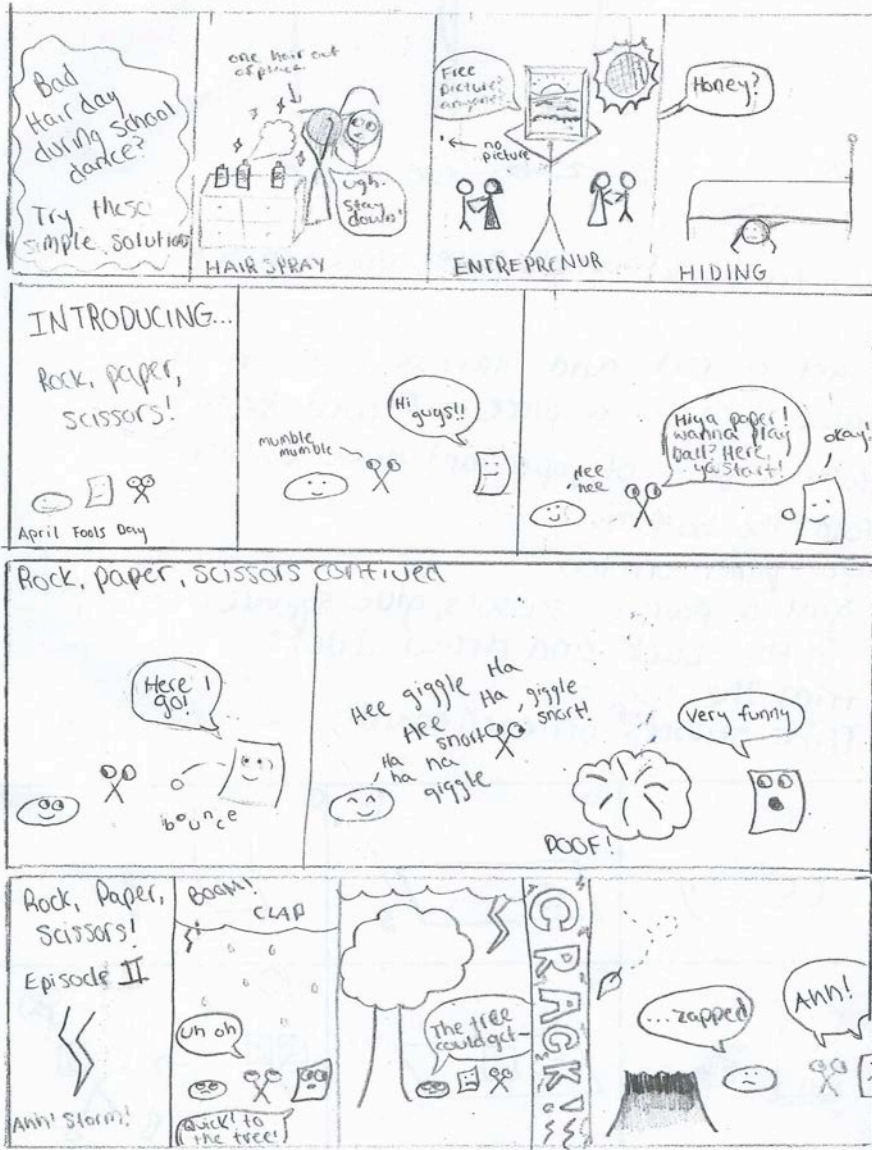
